In 2008 the *Local Government (Green Communities) Statutes Amendment Act* (Bill 27, 2008) included amendments to the *Local Government Act* which mandated local governments to include in their Official Community Plans, targets, policies, and actions that the local government will undertake to reduce the emission of greenhouse gas within their jurisdiction. Said amendments must be in place by May 31, 2010. Included in all proposed OCP and RLUB amendments are a definition of greenhouse gas, statistical information about emissions and targets for reduction, and strategies on how the Regional District proposes to reach the goals for emission reduction.

At the public hearings, all those who deem their interest to be affected by the proposed bylaws shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions. Please note that emails cannot be accepted as written submissions. Any material received before or at the public hearings will become public information. The hearings will be chaired by a delegate of the Regional District Board. Copies of the resolution regarding the delegation, proposed bylaws and relevant background documents, may be examined at the office of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George, 155 George Street, Prince George, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. February 25, 26, March 1, 2, and 3, 2010.
