Nomination Forms Now Available to Fill Area F Vacancy

Nomination packages are now available for people interested in filling the position of Director for Electoral Area F (Willow River-Upper Fraser) with the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George. The position fills the remainder of a three year term and will expire in December 2008.

The communities of Foreman, Shelley, Willow River, Giscome, Upper Fraser, Sinclair Mills, Longworth and Penny are located within Area F, representing a population of just over 1300.

The position became available when former Director Shelley Zenzen was killed in a tragic motor vehicle accident in December.

Nomination documents are available from the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George website (www.rdffg.bc.ca) or at the Regional District office at 155 George Street during regular business hours.

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as an electoral area director if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian Citizen
- 18 years of age or older on voting day
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months at the time nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, elected to or holding office.

The deadline for receipt of nominations is 4:00pm Friday, February 29. If more than one candidate is nominated, a by-election will be held in early April.
