HIGH STREAMFLOW ADVISORY

The Province of British Columbia has issued a High Streamflow Advisory. No major flooding is expected at the present time. The following rivers and streams within the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George are included in this advisory:

- **the Fraser River, and all tributaries upstream from Quesnel, and**
- **the Nechako River and all tributaries upstream from Prince George.**

A High Streamflow Advisory means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly. Minor flooding in low lying areas is possible.

This is a preliminary advisory to those living or having interests located in low lying areas along rivers and streams in the Regional District.

If the rivers continue to rise, further warnings will be issued.
