



**NOTICE TO LANDOWNERS AND RESIDENTS IN LOW-LYING AREAS  
ALONG RIVERS, CREEKS AND WATER COURSES WITHIN  
THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF FRASER-FORT GEORGE**

The Province of British Columbia has advised that the snowpack in the Upper Fraser and Nechako basins is considerably higher than normal for this time of year. This extra snow increases the likelihood of flooding in low-lying areas.

Owners of properties in low-lying areas may want to consider making the following preparations:

- Move possessions out of reach of flood waters.
- Confirm your insurance coverage.
- Make arrangements to relocate pets and livestock.
- Prepare an emergency kit for you and your family to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours.
