**NOTICE OF
ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS**

Public Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, January 15, 2009, the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George intends to proceed with final passage and adoption of Foothills Boulevard Landfill Gas Emission Reduction Credit Transfer Contract Authorization Bylaw No. 2499, 2008 unless at least 10 percent of the persons qualified as electors petition the Regional District to not proceed without first obtaining the assent of the electors by voting.

Bylaw No. 2499 would authorize the Regional District to enter into a long term contract with Green Municipal Corporation (GMC) for the transfer and sale of emission reduction credits resulting from the collection and combustion of landfill gas at the Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill. The area affected by Bylaw No. 2499 includes all municipalities and electoral areas within the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George.
