MAIL BALLOTING INFORMATION

Persons who qualify as resident electors or non-resident property electors for a voting jurisdiction are eligible to cast their ballots by mail provided that they:

- have a physical disability, illness or injury that prevents them from voting at an authorized voting opportunity; or
- reside within the voting jurisdiction but more than 90 kilometres from the closest polling station at which they are entitled to vote; or
- expect to be absent from the Regional District on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities.

In order to vote by mail ballot an application must be submitted on the prescribed form to the Chief Election Officer. The Chief Election Officer will require each applicant to provide personal information to corroborate the ballot request, as well as a signed declaration attesting to the applicant's eligibility to vote as requested.

Applications for mail balloting are subject to challenge in the same manner as any other voting application. An applicant will only be provided with those ballots which have been specifically requested and for which the Chief Election Officer believes the applicant to be qualified as an elector.

In cases where the mail ballot applicant is seeking to vote as a non-resident property elector, written consent of the majority of the property owners of the real property that is within the voting jurisdiction is required. This consent may be provided on the consent form provided concurrently with the mail ballot application.
