

1. Will the clearcut portion of the FLTCs (15.0 ha) have a silviculture levy on them?

Each of the FLTCs are less than 5.0 ha and therefore will NOT have a silviculture levy.

2. Have you asked the MOF if burning all of the wood will result in a penalty to the FLTC license holder?

The MOF will assess the waste prior to burning and there will likely be no penalty. Only billing on legitimate waste. Prior to contract award, the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George will obtain confirmation that there will be no penalty or will pay the penalty if it applies.

3. If all of the wood is burned or cut into firewood, how will the MOF calculate the stumpage owing, will it be based the volumes in the FLTC calculation?

If licensee wants to burn or make firewood, the MOF needs to assess the waste prior to burning or selling as special product. If firewood is made, then the MOF will scale the firewood and the stumpage on firewood is \$0.50/m³. The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George will pay the stumpage if it applies.
