Question:

This question refers to the analytical parameter tables in the back of the RFP document.

It was noticed that in the row next to the subsection headings (i.e., Field Observations, General Chemistry, Nutrients, Metals Dissolved Total, QA/QC) there are some X's and some left blank. Should they be ignored (X's adjacent Field Observations, General Chemistry, Nutrients, QA/QC); and when X's beside both Dissolved and Total occur, that you require both analyses conducted at these locations (i.e., groundwater monitoring wells and leachate/condensate samples)?

Response:

Xs next to the header titles field observations, nutrients, general chemistry and QA/QC should be ignored. Xs occurring beside metals dissolved and total means that both analyses are required at these locations.
