



Invitation to Tender ES-11-05
Chain Link Fence Installation – Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill
Mandatory Site Meeting – Tuesday, May 17, 2011, 10:00 a.m.

Meeting Minutes

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- First Stop:**
- Connect to the fence here and run along the North side to the gate, the left side to the manhole. Once you hit the fence, jog out and go around the manhole on inside of fence line.
 - Is this site going to be prepared? Will put grader on and clean up a bit, but fence can go on the flat part, 1m from the berm.
 - Chain link fabric will go on the outside of the posts which is the south side towards the gravel pit.
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- Second Stop:**
- Regional District will clean up around the gate. Will be a straight shot up to here through the gravel pit.
 - **Measurements on the map provided in the tender documents are from GIS and are APPROXIMATE. Contractors are expected to do their own accurate set of measurements.**
 - The stake at the bottom of the hill is where the fence will terminate.
 - Fence line will be 1m back from the edge so any sloughing is not against the fence. Chain link fabric will go on the outside which is the south side of post towards the hillside. The stake at the top of the hill is at the fence line. One gate will be going up here in the gravel pit on the other side of the yellow manhole.
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- Third Stop on other side of site at second fence location:**
- This side is loam, not gravel.
 - Tie in to existing fence and line up with stake. The fence line is to go on the North side so the roadway is on the inside of the property.
 - Will the piled up debris stay? Yes, it will be left as is.
 - The low spots of the road that are rough will be cleaned up by the Regional District so that you can drive in. The ground here turns to hard packed when dry.
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- Contractors are welcome to come back to the site to take measurements at their convenience, during facility operating hours. Contractors must sign in and out at the scale house and let the scale house operator know why they are there.
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- Documents are available at the Regional District office at 155 George Street for a cost of \$25, or on the Regional District website for no charge.
 - There is already one addendum posted. Fill out your acknowledgement letter and send it in if you want to receive amendments, otherwise they will be posted on the Regional District's web page.
 - All addendums should be included in the tender submissions.
