1. Question:

Does each fire department have the same Occupational Health and Safety ("OH&S") manual, or is each different? Will they be made available electronically?

Answer:

Appendix "A" of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George Fire Rescue Operational Guidelines Manual contains the region-wide standardized OH&S Program. This standardized program is the same for all of the fire and rescue services. The Operational Guidelines Manual is available in electronic format on the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George's website at http://www.rdffg.bc.ca/Services/Public_safety/Fire_rescue.html. The OH&S Program contained in Appendix "A" of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George Fire Rescue Operational Guidelines Manual is the minimum standard required for each fire and rescue department. Individual departments have been permitted to develop these programs further and therefore some departments may have additional program information. Any additional information for a department's enhanced OH&S Program can be made available for review prior to a site visit.
