

Pelican Complex
Fire Travel / Fire Danger Advisory

Please be aware that The Pelican Complex is still a working fire area, and as a result certain hazards exist within and adjacent to the fire perimeter, including;

- REMEMBER! Fire suppression staff and equipment are actively working and fire fighters and suppression equipment are located along road right of ways. Please drive slowly, with lights and 4 way flashers on at all times.
- WATCH FOR LARGE TRUCKS / HEAVY EQUIPMENT AND GIVE RIGHT OF WAY FOR PASSAGE. Fire traffic is monitoring forestry channels, and will not be expecting you.
- Danger Trees are present in many areas and adjacent to road corridors. Trees damaged by fire or with compromised root systems can fall at any time with no warning! While Danger Tree Assessors continue to check the road right of ways, roads can be blocked by falling trees at any time so caution is urged.
- Active tree felling may be occurring, which may require temporary road closures. Watch for Danger Signage and adhere to directions / traffic spotters.
- FOR YOUR SAFETY - MAXIMUM SPEED WITHIN THE FIRE AREA IS RESTRICTED TO 40 Km / Hr.
- Smoking debris / small flare ups are possible within the fire perimeter. Please watch for changing fire conditions, and evacuate if required.
