Invitation to Tender ES-17-05 Aerial Survey Services – Regional Landfills and Community Sewage Systems

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Invitation to Tender to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Tenderers shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their tender.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

1) Question: In the Invitation to Tender, it states that "Aerial surveys are carried out to determine, with high accuracy, current ground elevations to determine..." Does this mean that the Regional District is only requesting contours/elevations and ortho, and is not requesting full planimetric data collection (i.e. roads, poles, posts, buildings, scales, etc.)?

Answer: All features within the described areas of the sites listed within the Invitation to Tender are expected to be picked up during the survey. Please refer to Section 3. Introduction and Background.

2) **Question:** In the Invitation to Tender, it states the following timeline:

Award of Contract: no later than **April 21, 2017** Commencement of Contract: **May 01, 2017**

All deliverables for Mackenzie and Foothills Landfills: May 10, 2017

This implies that the contractor would have 10 days to fly the two sites to collect aerial photography, collect ground control, do aerial triangulation, collect elevation data (and maybe planimetric data), create orthophotos, and create and print map sheets. With this timeline, there doesn't seem to be room for delays in data collection (photo is at the mercy of the weather) or other issues that can occur. Please confirm that this 10 day window is correct and if there is some flexibility in the delivery dates.

Answer: All maps, data, drawings, photos and other work required by the contractor to fulfill the terms of the contract regarding the Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill and the Mackenzie Regional Landfill must be submitted to the Regional District by May 10th, 2017. For the six (6) other optional sites, if proceeded on, all aerial surveys must be complete by May 20, 2017 and all maps, data, drawings, photos and other work required by the contractor to fulfill the terms of the contract regarding the six (6) other optional sites must be submitted by May 31, 2017. Any changes in the survey and the deliverables due dates will only be because of adverse weather conditions and agreed upon by the Regional District.
