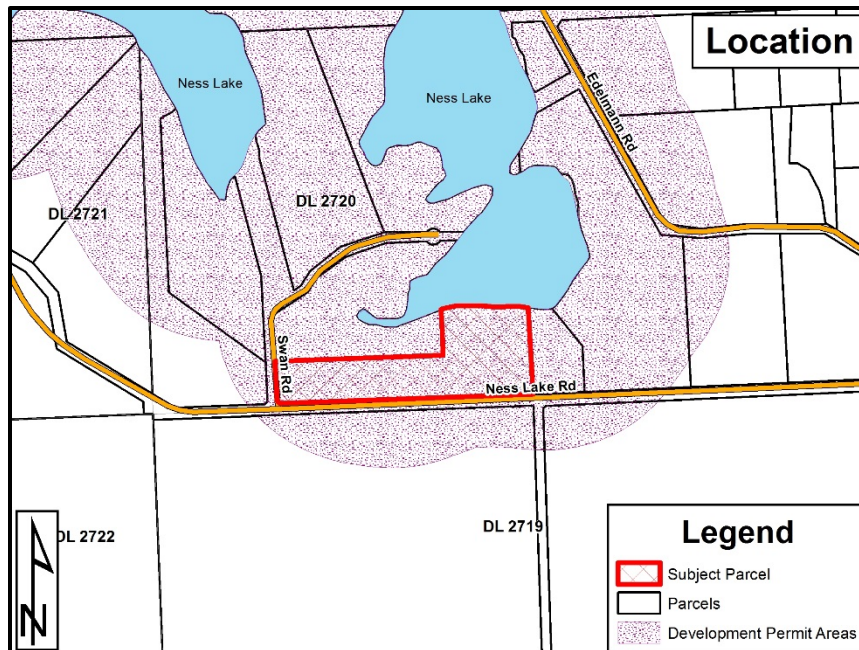
What: Regional District Board considering issuance of Development Permit with Variance No. 1218

Proposal: Development Permit with Variance No. 1218 specifically varies Section 17.0(7)(c)(iii) of Regional District of Fraser-Fort George Zoning Bylaw No. 2892 by increasing the combined maximum total floor area of accessory buildings, prior to a Residential-Single Family Use being established on the property, from 50m² to 149m² in a Development Permit Area. The variance is being proposed to allow the construction of a pole barn. The Development Permit with Variance applies to the property legally described as Lot 1 District Lot 2720 Cariboo District Plan 24144 and the property is located at 22790 Ness Lake Road.



How can I provide comment? Anyone who believes that their interest in land is affected by the proposed permit shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to submit written comments prior to the Regional District Board considering issue of the permit.
