



Addendum No. 1

Invitation to Quote ES-17-03

Spray Irrigation Services Tabor Lake Community Sewer System

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Invitation to Quote (ITQ) to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the ITQ Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Bidders shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their quote.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

Remove the following wording under **GENERAL DUTIES**, page 20:

“ ▪ supply fuel, lubricants and filters for pumping equipment.”

Remove the following wording under **OPERATING HOURS**, page 19:

“The Contractor will deliver the Work specified herein at the Facility during the spray irrigation operating season from May 1st to October 31st. Pre-spray irrigation work typically occurs from April 15th to April 30th. Spray irrigation operations typically occur from May 1st to September 30th. Spray irrigation work may extend beyond September 30th.”

Shall be changed to read:

“The Contractor will deliver the Work specified herein at the Facility during the spray irrigation operating season from May 1st to October 31st. **Pre-spray irrigation work typically occurs the first two weeks of May, to line up with initial lagoon sampling for permission to spray.** Spray irrigation operations typically occur from May 1st to September 30th. Spray irrigation work may extend beyond September 30th.”

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

Spray Irrigation Services – Tabor Lake Community Sewer System

THIS CONTRACT made this ____ day of _____ in the year of 2017 by and between the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George, herein after called the “Regional District” and _____, herein after called the “Contractor”.

WITNESSETH: That the Contractor and the Regional District undertake and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor will:
 - (a) provide all necessary materials, labour, supervision, and equipment and perform all work, and fulfil everything as set forth in and in strict accordance with the Contract Documents for the project entitled “ES-17-03 - Spray Irrigation Services – Tabor Lake Community Sewer System” from May 1, 2017 to October 31, 2017, and
 - (b) commence to actively proceed with the Work of the Contract on May 1, 2017.
2. The Regional District will pay to the Contractor as full compensation for the performance and fulfilment of this Contract, the sum or sums of money specified herein in the manner and at the times specified in the Contract Documents.
3. The Schedule of Prices, List of Contractor’s Personnel, List of Sub-Contractors, Contractor’s Experience in Similar Work, General Conditions of Contract, Contract Agreement and other Securities, General Conditions, Operational Specifications, and all addenda are incorporated herein, to the intent and purpose as though recited in full herein, and the whole will form the Contract and will endure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors, executors, administrators, and assigns.
4. No implied contract of any kind whatsoever, by or on behalf of the Regional District, will arise or be implied from anything contained in this Contract or from any position or situation of the parties at any time, it being understood and agreed that the express contracts, covenants and agreements made herein by the parties hereto are and will be the only contract, covenants and agreements on which any rights against the Regional District may be founded.
5. Subject to Section 3, this Contract will supersede all communications, negotiations, and agreements, either written or verbal, made between the parties hereto in respect of matters pertaining to this Contract prior to the execution and delivery hereof.

6. All communications in writing between the parties will be deemed to have been received by the addressee if delivered to the individual, or to a member of a firm, or to the General Manager of Environmental Services of the Regional District for whom they are intended, or if sent by registered mail or by telegram as follows:
