Question: The application procedure for this Invitation to tender states that a corporate seal must be used. To my knowledge there is no legal requirement in Canada for a corporate seal on any document to be accepted. It also seems odd that a corporate seal is required as this would imply that only a corporation may apply for this request and the Tender is focusing on excluding other business entities such as proprietary companies. This seems to be a formality which our company has never encountered and while we are incorporated, we do not have a corporate seal. We have no intention of purchasing a corporate seal and we do not wish to proceed with our application if it is going to be refused on a technicality that is irrelevant to the application procedure or the proposed project.
