- Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day Saturday, June 5, 2021;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
